Horse back riding, care of, and exposure to horses, and the use of any horse or horseback riding equipment involves risk and danger, and/or injury. The behavior of the horse can be unpredictable, and at times based on instinct or fright, which may cause injury. Horses may bite, kick, buck, lie down, stumble, or fall. Saddles may slip, tack may loosen, and wear tear may cause tack problems. All efforts will be made to make sure equipment remains serviceable and safe, but unforeseeable events could occur. Terrain ridden is subject to change, due to weather and natural causes. Terrain, and obstacle variations could cause loss of control, and, or injury.

Signature of this form admits awareness that this activity entails risks of injury or death. I understand that the description of these risks is incomplete, and that unknown or unanticipated risks may occur. I agree to assume responsibility for all identified and unidentified risk factors. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary, and I elect to participate, despite the previously mentioned risks. I further agree not to hold Green Country Dressage Chapter, Lily Pond, or others affiliated with the GCDC Fall Young Riders camp responsible for any accidents that may occur.

I certify that I am, or my minors are, fully capable of participating in this activity, and assume full responsibility for myself, and minor children, for bodily injury, death, and loss of personal property, and all expenses thereof, as a result of those inherent risks and dangers, and of any negligence in participating in this activity. I have read this, agree with it, and have advised my child or ward to obey rules of GCDC and Lily Pond. I personally carry hospital insurance on my child or ward and accept this responsibility.

I have read, understood, and accepted the terms and conditions stated herein and acknowledge that this agreement shall be effective and binding upon myself, my heirs, assigns, personal representative, estate, and for all members of my family, including minors accompanying me, or participating in anything involved with horses, events, or activities related to horses, and fund raising both on and off Lily Pond, and associated with their owners, employees, or associates of Green Country Dressage Chapter and their board, volunteers, and associated instructors.

I am participating in the Equine sport at my own risk. I understand this is a high risk sport. I hereby assume all risks for myself, any family members or others, for whom I am assuming responsibility, and do hereby release and hold harmless GCDC and Lily Pond, their owners, agents, employees, guests and any other visitors or animal owners, (who's animals may be used as lesson horses) from all liability for negligence, resulting in accidents, damage, injury or illness to myself, my children or others, for whom I have assumed responsibility, my, or their property, including the horse(s) which I, or they, may ride. I agree to wear, and have my children, or others, for whom I am responsible, wear protective headgear while riding. When participating in dressage activities, I agree to wear and have my children or others, for whom I am responsible, wear, protective headgear, with harness secured, which meets the standards currently imposed by USEF Rules. I understand and agree that GCDC and Lily Pond, its owners, agents and employees may refuse to allow and prohibit or stop any activity deemed improper or unsafe.

Rules while at Lily Pond

Please Respect these rules so our hosts will invite us back next year!

Any person riding a horse (their own or anyone else's), on facilities, must have a signed Release of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement on file. If the rider is a minor, a parent or legal guardian must sign this agreement.

Anyone riding a horse at on the facility must wear a riding helmet and approved footwear at all times. No sneakers or low top shoes, which could get caught in a stirrup, will be allowed.

While in the barn, all horses must be secured, either on cross ties, tied to a stall or cross tie post, or within a stall. Horses may not be left standing alone, untied, in the aisle.

Owners/riders must promptly clean up messes, including manure, hoof cleaning residue, hair clippings, whether in the aisle or in a stall.

Owners/riders are responsible for cleaning and putting away their tack and equipment and helping to keep the tack room clean and orderly.

Horses, other than one's own, may not be used, without the owner's express permission. Permission must be provided to GCC, or Lily Pond in writing.

Owners/riders must accompany horses at all times while they are not in their stall or tied to their trailer

All horses must be dismounted prior to entering the barn.

No running, screaming or rough housing while at the facility.
