- The Championship show will be conducted like a USDF Recognized show. As well as the Western Dressage will follow the WDAA rules. Headgear required per USEF guidelines.
  - 2 Qualifying scores at the highest test of the level, with the exception of Intro, from 2 different judges at 2 different shows for 2011. Shows must have been GCC & ODS approved. Horse & rider must be registered with ODS and GCC to be eligible for Championships for 2011

GUIDELINES for Protective Headgear: The US Equestrian Federation passed rule DR120.5 "Protective Headgear for Dressage", which will go into effect March 1, 2011. Effective March 1, 2011, for dressage: Anyone mounted on a horse must wear a riding helmet, with the harness secured, meeting or exceeding the ASTM SEI standards for equestrian use, except those riders age 18 and over while on horses that are competing only in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above (including FEI Young Rider Tests, the USEF Developing Prix St. Georges Test and the USEF Brentina Cup Test).

**FAILURE to do so after reminder will incur elimination from the competition.**

*Juniors, amateurs and open riders will ride together but be placed separately. Show management reserves the right to change ride times when deemed necessary to facilitate timely completion of the show. Entries must be received by closing date at 5:00 p.m. Late entries may be refused or charged a late fee of \$20 at the discretion of the show management. If cancellations are necessary a full refund will be made if the show manager is notified before the closing date. All fees must be paid by the closing date unless prior arrangement is made with the show manager. In such case all fees will be due before entering the arena. After closing date, refunds will be made only with a doctor or veterinarian certificate, less \$10 office fee. All no-show entries will be billed to the rider*
