**Guidelines For Protective Headgear: The US Equestrian Federation passed rule DR120.5 "Protective Headgear for Dressage," which will go into effect as of March 1, 2011. Effective March 1, 2011, for dressage: Anyone mounted on a horse must wear a riding helmet, with the harness secured, meeting or exceeding the ASTM SEI standards for equestrian use, except those riders age 18 and over while on horses that are competing only in FEI levels and tests at the Prix St. Georges level and above (including FEI Young Rider Tests, the USEF Developing Prix St. Georges Test and the USEF Brentina Cup Test).**

**Failure to do so after one reminder will incur elimination from the competition.**

*Juniors, amateurs, and open riders will ride together but be placed separately JUNIORS WILL SHOW IN APPROPRIATE AGE BRACKETS: 12 & under and 13-over; not to have reached their 18th birthday by Dec. 1 of membership year). Show management reserves the right to change ride times when deemed necessary to facilitate timely completion of the show. Entries must be received by closing date at 5:00 p.m. Phone, email and late entries may be refused. A late /phone-in fee of \$5/class will be charged at the discretion of the show management. If cancellations are necessary, a full refund will be made if the show manager is notified before the closing date. All fees must be paid by the closing date. After closing date, refunds will be made only with a doctor or veterinarian certificate, less \$10.00 office fee. All no-show entries will be billed to the rider. Horse/rider entries may be limited to two classes if show is overbooked.*

- When jacket not worn, short sleeve shirts may be worn, no tank tops please
- USEF 2011 tests will be used
- High points awarded (Jr under 13; Jr 14-18; Adult Amateur; Open) for each of the levels
- Stallions must be attended at all times
- Horses not to be shown must have a negative Coggins presented at the office. A donation to GCC would be appreciated for admittance of horses not to be shown
- Attention Riders check your scores for accuracy USEF Rule DR123.8: if a mathematical error is discovered, it must be brought to the attention of competition management within 1 hour of the official posting of the scores from the last class of that competition day
- Head gear : Refer to the headgear guidelines for USEF on the following page
- Footwear: Boots with Heels
- Horses may not be ridden in more than a total of 5 classes per day when used in Intro and Training level classes, a maximum of 3 rides per day when the horse is ridden in 1<sup>st</sup> level or above. This does include suitability classes. If there is a question please consult Show manager.
